Electronic Version of Quilt Show Entry Form

This is an optional version of the paper Quilt Show Entry Form that can be filled out on your computer. Here are some instructions for doing so. You may, of course, still use a paper copy of the form.

Fill out this form on your computer using Acrobat Reader or similar program. Then you may print it and deliver it to the registrar or you may save it and attach it to an email to the registrar.

Step by step:

- 1. Fill out the form.
- 2. Print it and proofread it so you have a paper copy in case you need to give it to the registrar.
- 3. Save the filled out form using "save as" on the file menu. Give it a unique filename such as (your name)entry1. Example: CatheeHimelEntry2.pdf. Remember where you saved it so you can find it later. Each entry must be saved to a different filename.

Do the above for each of your quilt entries.

Attach all the saved entry files to an email (preferred). Email it to quilts@shimel.com.

- 1. Complete one form per quilt. No previous years' entries will be accepted.
- 2. All entries must be labeled with the owner's name & safety pinned or sewn to **BOTTOM LEFT CORNER OF THE BACK** of quilt.
- 3. We MUST have accurate quilt dimensions.
- 4. All quilts must have a 4" sleeve on the back for hanging (except miniature). May be permanently or temporarily attached. **NO PINS OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED ON SLEEVE**.
- 5. Place each quilt in a <u>clear</u> plastic bag folded with your name in the lower left corner of the back with your name facing up placed in the bag and SHOWING.
- 6. Quilt drop off: Thursday, Aug. 3, between 9:00 am and NOON at Hope Church, 5002 Bickford Ave, Snohomish.
- 7. Pick up: Saturday, Aug. 5, after all equipment & quilts are taken down.

Remember, ENTRY FORMS must be received no later than July 20.
